Location and Key Dates

The venue allows for an unforgettable blend of sport, family fun, and adventure, With Climbing Walls, Bouncy Castles, Table Tennis and touch rugby for parents available.

Rugby played at Chichester College, Westgate Fields, Chichester, PO19 1SB

- Arrive Friday 1st May
- Rugby on both Saturday 2nd May and Sunday 3rd May
- Depart either Sunday 3rd May or Monday 4th May
- Whole club events on evenings of Friday 1st, Sat 2nd and Sun 3rd May

Cost Information

Rugby – £110 per person (players and spectators) payable on X date via X link, which provides:

- Entry wristbands for both days of rugby
- Medals for all players
- Transport on Saturday and Sunday (morning and evening) from Seal Bay to the rugby and back again
- Live music on Saturday evening and large marquee (300/ 400+ capacity) with dance floor, stage, live band, bar, etc
- Pre-paid BBQ buffet dinner on Saturday evening with designated seating inside the marquee

Accommodation costs are not covered in the £110 per person “rugby cost”, and accommodation needs to be arranged separately by each family.


Seal Bay Resort offers a wide range of family caravans from £240 to £840 from Friday to Monday, for which we have a group reservation. These must be booked by 31st October 2025. See details below on the accommodation booking process.

Seal Bay Resort is approximately 15 mins drive from the rugby festival venue. Shuttle coaches will be provided to and from Seal Bay on Saturday and Sunday. Timings to be confirmed at a later date.

There are fantastic onsite facilities including:

- Swimming pools, Arcade & amusements, Outdoor play and mini golf, Restaurants and beach access and nightly entertainment for kids and adults alike.
- We would love as many people as possible to stay at this location to create a ‘one club’ atmosphere.

When live, a link will be shared to book accommodation. We have reserved 62 Caravans, and you can view the actual caravans via www.csholidaylets.co.uk.



There is also camping available at touring park which is on site of Selsey Bay please speak to tour group reps if you wish to camp.

There are many accommodation options in and around Chichester, which can be booked independently should you wish to stay elsewhere. It is not mandatory to stay at the Seal Bay Resort and each family can choose to stay in whichever accommodation they prefer.

Friday 1st May – Welcome & meet at Seal Bay Bar Solent View – Waterfront Complex

- Arrival and check-in at Seal Bay (check in available from 4pm)
- 7pm - gather in the OA reserved area for drinks and dinner (this is not covered by the tour price - i.e this is "pay as you go" for everyone)

Saturday 2nd May – Rugby at Chichester College (timings are subject to change due to rugby schedule)

- 9am: Complimentary transport on 60-seater coaches for our touring players and families to leave at 9am (timings subject to change depending on fixture schedules) There will be multiple coaches to cater for our tour party size.
- 9.30am: Team registration at Chichester College
- 10am: Referee and coach briefings at Chichester College
- TBC am: Opening Rugby ceremony for all players
- 11am: First matches kick off (fixtures will be shared via age group representative)
- 1.15pm: Lunch and parents touch rugby
- 2-5pm: Rugby fixtures run throughout the afternoon alongside activities for all the family; bouncy castle, face painting, obstacle inflatables, climbing wall with Pavilion Bar open throughout the day
- 6pm: All OA's teams meet in a reserved marquee area where food will be provided. Jungle Party with themed dress, group photos, live music, and Player of the Day awards
- 8:30pm – First busses leave back to Seal Bay
- 9:30pm – Final busses leave back to Seal Bay
